



Elrick Nursery Outdoor Storytelling Sessions

Celebrate Spring with our outdoor-themed storytelling sessions, designed to inspire us to sing, read and rhyme outside.

Who, Where and When?

Elrick Nursery Outdoor Storytelling Sessions are for children who attend Elrick Nursery and their parent or other carer.

Storytelling sessions are weekly. Each session lasts approx. 45 minutes and will involve up to 6 children and their families.

Sessions run throughout the term at Arnhall Moss on a Thursday: 10.00am – 10.45am and are repeated again at 1.30pm – 2.15pm

What's involved?

After an initial welcome to each day's theme, we explore the wood looking for interesting items to collect. We then arrive at 'camp' (with temporary tarpaulin shelter if weather is bad) to find out about the things we've collected. There will be an opportunity to meet some special forest friends and together we will sing songs and explore action rhymes. There is also time for snack – rich tea biscuits and water or cosy milk. We then make our way back to Nursery where the children will have an opportunity to play for the remainder of their session.

Not just for children!

Parents/carers play an active role in each session. This is an ideal opportunity for children and their families to enjoy quality time while exploring new songs and stories. We hope that you will be inspired to carry on exploring nature stories out with Nursery!

What do we bring?

Please ensure you are all dressed appropriately, with the necessary waterproofs, footwear, hats and/or sunscreen.
