Writing - We are using "Talk for Writing" techniques to add artistic flair and detail to our imaginative and personal pieces.

Learning Across the Curriculum

This term we are looking at Energy Conservation and Climate Change in Antarctica. We are watching a documentary about a research base in Antarctica and creating our own mini research projects - ask us about what we have discovered so far.

We are also exploring democracy and the electoral system.

Maths: This term we are looking at percentages and their relationship with fractions and decimals.
