CLASSROOM NEWS

In **maths**, we are starting to extend and develop our understanding of multiplication and division, including exploring visual representation of multiplication found in the Japanese method. Additionally, we will be revisiting and moving forward in fractions and decimal relationship. In **writing**, we are continuing to use 'Talk for Writing' and are currently working on our second paragraph of our 'game' narrative. This paragraph includes a task master/host setting up the story and explaining what the characters have to do to win.

In **science**, we will continue to develop our understanding of how animals and their environments change through time. Fossils provide a window into the animals and habitats of the past. Analyzing the traits of animals provides evidence for how those traits vary, how they are inherited, and how they have changed over time. For **topic** we have finished our Paper Mache landscape representing the Battle of Stirling bridge. We will now be working co-operatively and making our thinking visible to predict and report how we think the Scottish won the battle using an aerial photo of our landscape.

Our **P.E.** field hockey lessons are providing a challenge as it requires patience and predicting where the ball will go, which are new skills that they are developing.

We are continuing to work on our co-operative learning in **HWB**. This includes teamwork, listening and responding to others views respectfully and communication skills.

Over the last few weeks we have been hard at work in **expressive arts**, preparing for our upcoming Christmas Concert, which includes interacting with and guiding our soon to be P1 buddies.

In **art** we are exploring and reinventing the work of Wassily Kandinsky.
